



STATE AUTHORIZATION

Federal Regulations require an institution to disclose whether its programs prepare graduates for any state licensure or certification to work in the field of study.

Programs that Prepare Graduates for State Licensure or Certification

- Medical Assisting
- Medical Billing and Coding Specialist
- Pharmacy Technology
- Professional Clinical Massage Therapy
- Occupational Therapy Assisting
- Radiologic Technology
- Diagnostic Medical Ultrasound
- Nursing
- Surgical Technology
- Cosmetology

These programs are regulated occupations in **South Carolina** or have national certification or registry.

- The Medical Assisting program offered by Southeastern College prepares graduates for the Registered Medical Assistant (RMA) and the Certified Medical Assistant (CMA) examination.
- The Medical Billing and Coding Specialist program offered by Southeastern College prepares graduates for the Certified Billing and Coding Specialist (CBCS) examination.
- The Pharmacy Technology program offered by Southeastern College prepares graduates for the Certified Pharmacy Technician examination (CPHT).
- The Professional Clinical Massage Therapy program offered by Southeastern College prepares graduates for the Massage and Bodywork Licensing Examination (MBLEX). State licensure is required to work in the state of South Carolina.
- The Occupational Therapy Assisting program offered by Southeastern College prepares graduates for the Certified Occupational Therapy Assistant (COTA) examination. State licensure is required to work in the state of South Carolina.
- The Radiologic Technology program offered by Southeastern College prepares graduates for the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT) Radiography examination. State licensure is required to work in the state of South Carolina.
- The Diagnostic Medical Sonography program offered by Southeastern College prepares graduates for the American Registry of Radiologic Technologist (ARRT) Sonography examination.
- The Nursing program offered by Southeastern College prepares graduates for the National Council Licensure Examination for licensure as a Registered Nurse (NCLEX-RN). State licensure is required to work in the state of South Carolina.
- The Surgical Technology program offered by Southeastern College is seeking approval by the National Board of Surgical Technology and Surgical Assisting (NBSTSA) and accreditation by the Accrediting Bureau of Health Education Schools (www.abhes.org) for its graduates to apply for the national certification examination to become Certified Surgical Technologists (CST), for those students who have successfully met all education and institutional requirements.
- The Cosmetology program offered by the Southeastern College Columbia campus prepares graduates for state licensure with the South Carolina Department of Labor, Licensing and Regulation – State Board of Cosmetology.

The institution has not made any determination regarding licensure or certification requirements in the 49 other states and the District of Columbia. Applicants who move to another state should review the requirements for their respective programs for employment in that state.

No other programs offered by Southeastern College prepare students for occupations that require professional licensure.
