Students are encouraged to share comments and thoughts with staff through the use of our suggestion box. (Located next to front entrance of the student breakroom)



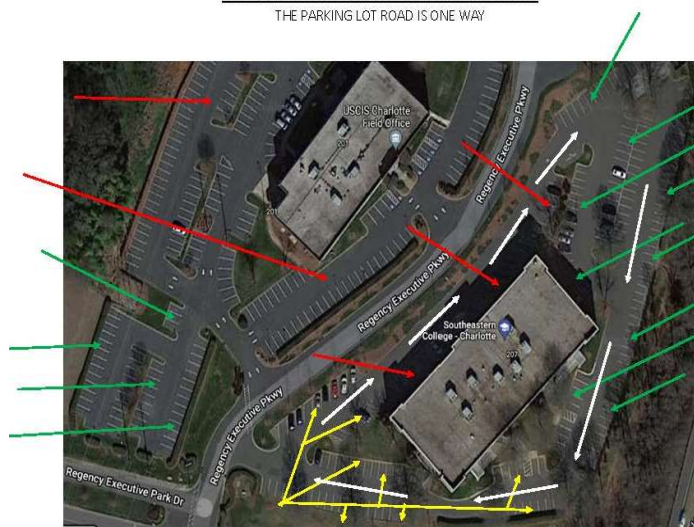
Parking Lot:

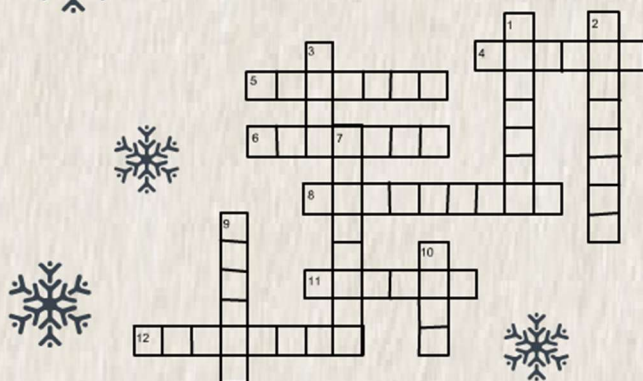
